


Skilled In Odisha

 - The Odisha Model must be worth emulating in other parts of the world





The Nano-Unicorn


- In Venture Capital parlance, an Internet start-up that gets a valuation of \$1 billion is called a Unicorn. Examples are Flipkart, OLA, Oyo
- India's real progress would depend nano-scale entrepreneurs that are today excluded from a sophisticated start-up ecosystem of Bengaluru, Gurugram or The Silicon Valley
- The Nano-Unicorn idea is an attempt to link skill training at the bottom of the pyramid to philanthropic capital
- A pilot has been kicked off with a goal to create 100 – 1000 – 3000 Nano-Unicorns






